Post lockdown, Ashok was attending school for the first time in his life.




Karm Marg is delighted to have Diya and Shibi in the team. we are looking forward for their contribution towards the organization.

SCIENCE EDUCATION

STEM Mela

Our colleagues Diya and Shibi organized their first STEM math at Karm Marg for community and Km children whom they are teaching for 2 months. It was a very good experience for children, they participated in every game like Games- udte Sitare, Jhapata Maar, Ganit Mala, shapes and Bangle games. These all games were based on number senses, addition and shapes.

Puppet workshop

Frank brother, an experienced puppeteer, conducted an interactive workshop with the children, teaching them how to make and operate their own puppets. Puppetry though a fun activity also is a powerful learning tool – it helped our children in developing imagination, creativity and learning behavioral skills, like speaking up with confidence, overcoming their shyness. The children gained valuable experience in creating their puppets and learning how to bring them to life with different movements and expressions.





Practical math

As the name suggests, the workshop was aimed at teaching practical applications of math in everyday life, such as managing finances, making purchases and measuring distances. Avishkaar had organized a workshop in Palampur for our staff and children. The participants found the experience extremely liberating in getting rid of phobia for Math.



Dance Movement Therapy (DMT)

Tara and Kajal attended a DMT workshop in Jaipur organized by Kolkata Sanved on mental health and well-being for their partner organization.
