IMPACTING CHANGE



Amrita came to KM in 2019. Devastated at the loss of her father at a tender age, she was heartbroken. She had to drop out of school due to financial constraints. Her mother who also happened to be KM alumni reached out to CWC for Amrita's rehabilitation.

The love, warmth, and consistent support of KM staff and caregivers managed to heal Amrita's pain greatly. Today, she is studying in class VIII and seems happy, confident, and determined to do well. A lead player in KM Frisbee team, Amrita dreams of becoming a professional makeup artist.

STAFF LEARNING: FACILITATION SKILLS IN JAMMU

Pooja had a remarkable opportunity to apply her skills acquired as a Life Camp facilitator during her training with Oasis Movement. She conducted a demo Life Camp for teachers at Jammu Government Boys School, engaging with a class of 40 children from 9th to 11th standard.



For Pooja, it was a huge leap of faith to travel alone, to a new city and engage with teachers and students in a formal setting. She also realized her potential as a facilitator which can steer her professional goal.

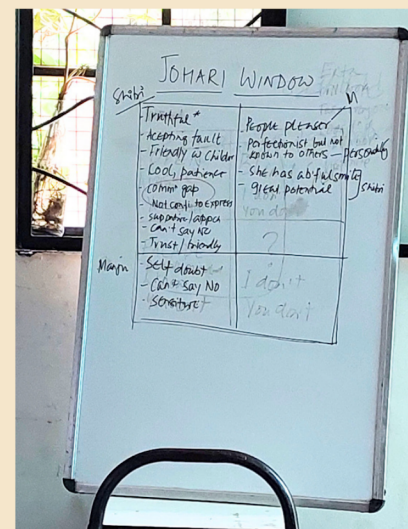


STAFF CAPACITY BUILDING: JOHARI WINDOW

Collaboration is the basis of all KM's work and thus trust in relationships among team members is vital.



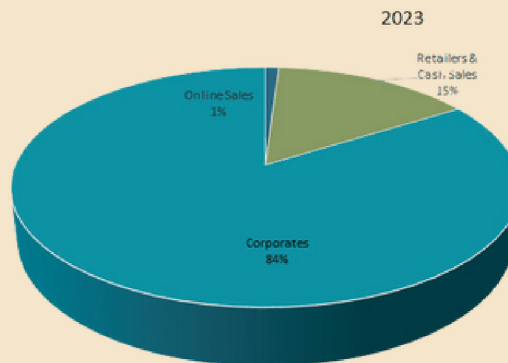
JUGAAD - TRANSFORMING LIVES OF VULNERABLE ADOLESCENT GIRLS

Jugaad's relationship with the girls who leave home under duress is phenomenal. They come here for a short duration until they are rehabilitated. During their stay, not only do they get exposed to vocational and practical academic skills but more importantly, Jugaad takes care of their mental well-being, especially those with special needs.

Jiya came to Delhi in search of work. She was the sole provider for her younger siblings with the demise of her parents. Unfortunately, Jiya got lost in Delhi and landed in KM through CWC. Jugaad did the initial handholding for Jiya till she could stand on her feet. Shabila from Jugaad patiently taught her stitching while encouraging her to pursue studies. Furthermore, playing frisbee was therapeutic for **Jiya**, it taught her to conquer fears and pursue her dream. Equipped with confidence, knowledge, skills, and renewed determination, Jiya is back home with her siblings. Girls like Jiya inspire us to overcome barriers by extending our hands to those who are in great need.
