



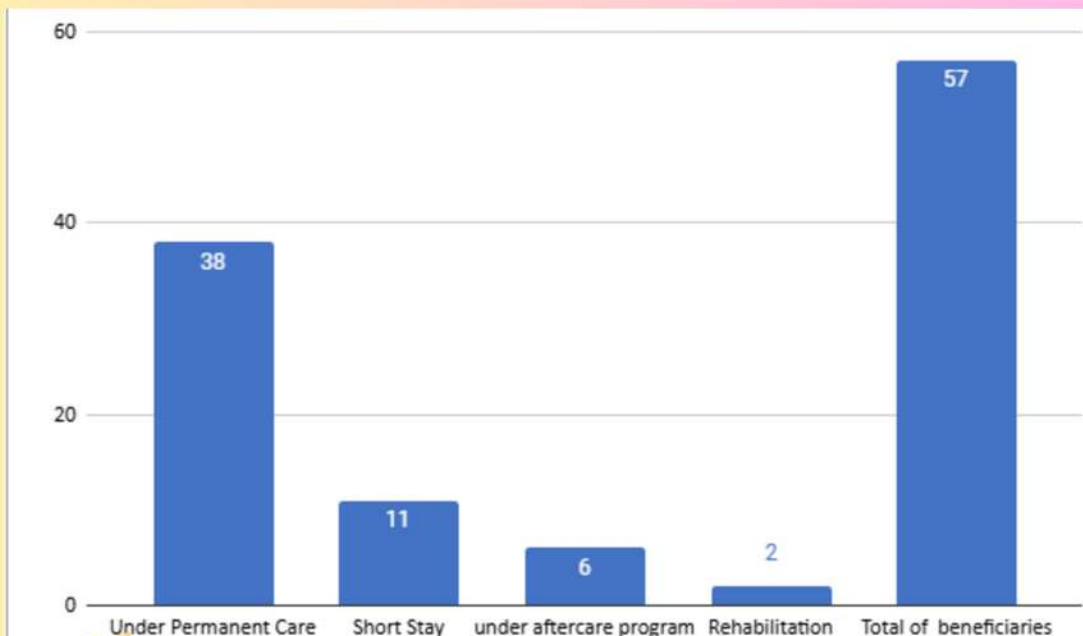
KARM MARG TURNS 28

SEEMA'S JOURNEY: A STORY OF QUIET STRENGTH

Seema (name changed) was just 11 when she was found alone in Faridabad and brought to Karm Marg through Childline and the Child Welfare Committee in 2015. She started with homeschooling, later joined regular school, but struggled to fit in and eventually dropped out in 9th grade.

We encouraged her to explore stitching as a skill. It didn't come easy—she was a slow learner, and progress took time. After turning 18, finding stable work was another hurdle. She tried working in a garment factory but left after two months—it just wasn't the right fit.



With continued training and support from Karm Marg, she found her calling working with children at an adoption NGO. After going through so much herself, she now uses her journey to care for those who've been left behind—offering them the same compassion she once needed. Today, she's confident, independent, and thriving—proof that even the quietest journeys can lead to beautiful destinations.

Currently, 34 children are enrolled in the program, and their growth has been truly inspiring.
