Despite his challenges, Rishi's spirit is incredibly vibrant.




He radiates joy and intelligence, and has quickly adapted to his new environment.

The **AHAM** Festival, organized by Shubham, a Dance Movement Therapy (DMT) practitioner and Kathak teacher for KM children, was a two-day celebration dedicated to mental wellbeing and self-celebration. During the event, the KM children showcased their Kathak performances, and Jugaad also had a stall. The festival was filled with various therapeutic activities, such as painting therapy, knitting, and clay therapy, creating a truly enriching experience for everyone involved.



Workshop On Good Touch and Bad Touch

Tanushree Didi conducted a workshop on 'Good Touch and Bad Touch' for younger children. The workshop was essential to raise their awareness and understanding on this topic. She conducted the session through storytelling to emphasize its importance. Twenty children attended the session.



Staff Training

- Pooja and Rachna attended the Empower Learning Journey workshop on 14th and 15th October 2024. The purpose of the two-day Learning Exchange program was to better understand the EMpower team and their areas of work, as well as to meet other grantee partners. This Learning Exchange was specifically organized for EMpower's partners in Uttar Pradesh and Delhi.
- Pooja attended a workshop on Safety and Risk Reduction for Vulnerable Children, organized by the District Child Protection Unit, Faridabad. The participants were sensitized about LGBTQ+, POCSO, HIV/AIDS. It was a great learning experience for everyone. . .

Ongoing Program Updates

Training of Teachers (ToT) Program: Our children (Simran, Shama, Ankita, and Tushar) are part of the Kolkata Sanved TOT program, learning to become DMT facilitators. In November, they attended a 3-day workshop with Abhass Trust children, where Kolkata Sanved facilitators closely observed and guided them. They learned how to engage children who were distracted by using tools and techniques they had learned earlier. Dance Movement Therapy (DMT) New Group: Beside this Program Kolkata Sanved also conducted 3 days of DMT residential workshop with the new children (12 children). They also distributed Certificate of Participation to all the past participants.

DMT for specially abled Adults : DMT for specially-abled started in September, and it has been the best thing for them. During the first three sessions, it was challenging to bring everyone together and engage them in activities. However, as the sessions progressed, we could clearly see the positive impact on everyone. For example, Ragini started speaking, Raju began participating in movements, and Pappu started enjoying sessions and attending regularly. All the credit goes to Sarika ji, who steered the process with such grace and patience.





Ultimate Frisbee:

Frisbee coaching is going well, and we can clearly see leadership skills developing in children like Devraj, Raju, Ankita, and Asif. Alongside Sohan, they are also helping prepare the Karm Marg B team and managing the community children who are attending Frisbee coaching. Currently, 25 children are participating in Frisbee coaching.

Digital Literacy

10 children from the community are attending Digital Literacy classes to build their basic computer skills.

27 children from Karm Marg have enrolled in Digital Literacy Program.



Life skill workshop


6 from community and 35 children from Karm Marg are taking life skill sessions.

It has been an insightful experience while engaging with children from community. First of all, it provides a great platform to learn from each other, understand differences, and work with them. Karm Marg offers a space for the children to express themselves, and speak up on matters close to their heart. Additionally, we also sensitize them on issues related to gender equality, mutual respect, managing boundaries and safe space.

Artreach India

Umesh Ji, an Artreach Teaching Fellow for 2024, has been conducting sessions since October 24. He has been teaching children puppet making, shadow puppetry, and object creation.

Artreach also aims to create an employability platform in the future for children who are particularly interested in art. In the past, two children received job opportunities through the program. Currently, 15 children are participating in this workshop.
